Operation Thank You is an outreach ministry of the So Help Me God Project, a 501(c)(3) non-profit organization that inspires faith, promotes patriotism, and supports our troops by providing inspirational and patriotic resources and programs that honor God, country, servicemembers, veterans, and military families. A brief overview of our current projects is listed below.

OPERATION THANK YOU is a special project to provide 150,000 troops with a signed card filled with heartfelt messages of support and encouragement. These professionally printed "Thank You" and "Get Well" cards have a pre-printed message along with blank lines for a personal message. The cards are generically addressed as "Dear Service Member" and "Dear Wounded Warrior" so they can be given to *any* military member. These cards become treasured keepsakes!



REMEMBERING THE FALLEN is a project to support families who have lost a loved one in the war. A specially designed grief packet contains the following resources: a letter of condolence, booklet about dealing with grief and loss, set of two "In Memory of an American Hero" dog tags/neck chains, music CD entitled "We Still Have Heroes: A Tribute to the Fallen," and contact information for organizations that help support families in time of grief and loss. A helpful resource for military chaplains, counselors, and family support groups.

SO HELP ME GOD is a special project to honor new chaplains in the U.S. Armed Forces. Upon graduation from their initial chaplain training, Army, Navy, and Air Force chaplains can receive a special handbook entitled, "So Help Me God: A Reflection on the Military Oath." This pocket-sized handbook has been used by over 1,000 chaplains to help servicemembers find courage, strength, and faith in times of conflict. The handbook encourages all service members to reflect on their spoken promise, their source of strength, and their personal commitment. A built-in Study Guide makes it a great resource for individual or small group study while away on a deployment.
